- started a new relationship
- begun cohabiting with your partner
- separated or divorced
- purchased or sold a home
- lost a family member, friend or someone who benefits under your Will
- welcomed new additions to the family, such as grandchildren
- considered guardians for young children, or changed your choice of guardian
- bought or sold a business
- made a significant gift to someone
- decided an executor is no longer suitable, or they have died
- bought or inherited foreign assets
- moved to or from overseas
- regularly provided financial assistance to someone
